Instructions: The Thinking scale requires that the impairment criteria, which appear at the top of each impairment category, are all true. However, for some items in this quiz, all of the impairment criteria may not be “spelled out,” especially if the symptoms are severe. In this quiz, assume that the impairment criteria are present, if the behavior/symptoms are severe. (Follow-up questioning in a real interview would likely elicit confirmation of the impairment criteria.)

1. 14 year old male was discharged from an inpatient unit 1 year ago. At the time he was admitted, he had auditory hallucinations, more specifically - voices were telling him to kill his parents. However, with medication and outpatient treatment, he has been able to maintain his day-to-day life. He currently attends school, maintaining a 3.0 grade average, and no longer hears voices.

2. 13 year old refuses to go to school and avoids his friends because he thinks the teachers and other students are talking about him in a “nasty” way. He has strange beliefs that he is certain are absolutely true although there is no evidence that they are true. These beliefs are clearly disruptive delusions. Affect is flat, and he appears to smile inappropriately. His mother is so concerned about him that she doesn't allow him to go out alone.

3. Mother died when child was 6. Now at the age of 12, she still believes occasionally that her mother talks to her when she wears a bracelet given to her by her mother. When she told her friends about it, they thought it was a bit weird.

4. 14 year old hears voices commanding him to hurt himself or others. His mother is so fearful that he may carry out these acts that she keeps him home from school – she never lets him go anywhere by himself. A psychiatrist is being consulted.

5. A youth lives in group home. He frequently draws pictures of bizarre and gory images all over his books, walls and homework. Peers are a little wary of him and his counselor has reported this behavior to the Director. He still goes to school and remains close with his circle of friends.

6. Child was recently admitted to a psychiatric hospital because he believed that his mother was trying to kill him by putting poison in a pot of corned beef. He will not eat any food that is not pre-packaged because he fears that it is poisoned. Since the onset of symptoms he has isolated himself from other children on the unit and is not allowed off the unit by himself.
